
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Map 1. Takelma Lands In Southwestern Oregon



Map 2. Takelma Indians





Map 3. Harrington Map 560 Medicine Rock At Sexton Mountain Pass





Map 4. Harrington Map 583 Indian Trail & Medicine Rock At Sexton Mountain Pass





Map 5. Harrington Map 876 Medicine Rock At Sexton Mountain Pass










Map 10. Hugo's Indian Trail


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Map 9. Hugo's Applegate Trails: Map II of IV

Map 10. Hugo's Applegate Trails: Map III of IV


