<u>1927 Homestead</u> On March 9, 1927 Edward Markham Squier was issued a 120 acre homestead patent in Hugo, Oregon (Patent No. 014565). <u>1861 Military Warrant</u> On November 11, 1861 President Abraham Lincoln issued John Davis and Lewis Heatt a military warrant (Patent No. 41877) for 160 acres in Josephine County, Oregon. <u>1899 Homestead</u> On May 31, 1899 William M. Cox ("Junior") were issued a homestead patent for 160 acres in Hugo, Oregon (Patent No. 4550).


