### Jacksonville Road (JR) Of Applegate Trail (*Trail*): Grave Creek Road (JA-17)<sup>1</sup>

**Hugo's Jacksonville Road (JA) from Willamette Valley to Jacksonville** (route of the *Trail*) is located in Josephine County, Oregon from Louse Creek in the south to Grave Creek in the north. There are 17 GLO surveyed points of interest (POI) along the JR in Hugo's area of interest.<sup>2</sup>



**Private Ownership** The 1855 GLO plot of JA-17 on the 1996 Glendale Quad identified the POI is located approximately 350' - 400' west of the Sunny Valley Road (SVR) on Tax Lot 1900. A high water crossing is identified on McLane's old Fort Leland's plot plan .4 miles upstream of trail (from GLO map).<sup>4</sup> A wide gravel bar is also identified .1 - .2 miles upstream of the covered bridge (from county GIS aerial photo). A smaller gravel bar is identified downstream of the bridge. The Josephine County tax lot map shows the width of Grave Creek wider upstream and downstream of the bridge location. The working hypothesis is that the 1855 ford of Grave Creek is 350' - 400' downstream of today's covered bridge. The 1856 GLO map matches the hypothesis.

#### Land Use & History


