

Hugo's Applegate Trail (Trail) GLO Houses¹

Hugo's two 1850s GLO emigrant *Trail* routes are located in Josephine County, Oregon from Louse Creek in the south to Grave Creek in the north.

- **JACKSONVILLE ROAD (JA) from Willamette Valley to Jacksonville**
- **ILLINOIS VALLEY (IV) ROAD to Illinois Valley via Van Noys Ferry**

Point of Interest (POI Code) The foundation for Hugo's 17 digit POI code is the Oregon-California Trails Association's mapping emigrant trails program.⁴⁻⁵

1853 Military Road There were three homes identified in 1853 along the JR between Louse Creek and Grave Creek: Miller, Rice, and Bates houses (Miller's House became Wagner's House; Rice's House unknown; Bate's House was Grave Creek House/Twoood's House).

1874 Josephine County Road Survey Another house was the Augustus L. Walker house associated with his donation land claim along Jumpoff Joe Creek.
