**1940** During July 1940 a bridal shower was held at the Community hall in honor of bride elect Fern Larson who became the bride of C. A. Erickson. Mr. and Mrs. C. A. Erickson would later travel on an extended honeymoon.<sup>6</sup>

Mrs. C. A. Erickson, President of the Hugo Ladies Club, was in charge of an aluminum drive. All residents were urged to donate every piece of aluminum that it was possible to give as America was gearing up for WWII.<sup>6</sup>
