Mrs. Alice McCormick died at Hugo, Ore., February 29, 1920. Alice Maloney was born at Leland, Ore., January 11, 1894, the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Thomas Maloney. She was taken sick on February 20, 1920 with influenza contracted from her husband who came home from his work on the evening of February 17, and immediately took his bed. After nine days of serve suffering Mrs. McCormick passed away.

Miss Alice Maloney was first married to Mr. Wiseman, 1905, by whom she had two children, Clair and Madge, respectively 13 and 10 years of age, who survive her.

On June 3, 1913, she married J. W. McCormick, who also survives her. Besides there are her mother, Mrs. Decker; two sisters, Mrs. Lillie Reed, and Winnie Maloney and Ernest Decker.

Mrs. McCormick was very well known in this section, having lived at Leland, Myrtle Creek, Kerby, Takilma and Grants Pass. Her last home was Hugo where Mr. McCormick is in the employ of the S. P. railroad. The funeral was held at 3 o'clock Tuesday.
