2007 Blaine McKy "Blaine M. McKy, 73, of Hugo died Tuesday, Dec. 18, 2007 at his home.

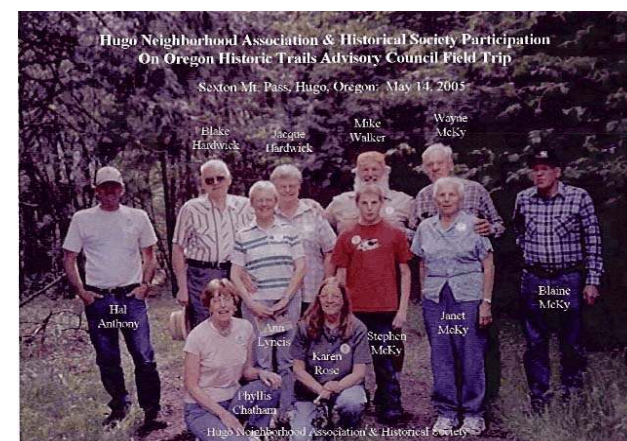

He was born Aug. 27 1934, in Grants Pass to Glen William McKy and Mildred Cecilia Ramsey McKy. In 1953, he graduated from Grants Pass High School. He worked for Southern Pacific Railroad before starting a career in the lumber industry. He worked for Bates Plywood Mill, Robert Dollar Company and Gregory Forest Products. He was treasurer of Local 3009 L&S Lumber and Sawmill workers.
