1884 Hugo Homestead On April 24,1884 William Asher was issued a homestead patent for 160 acres in the bottom lands of Bummer Creek in Hugo, Oregon (Patent No. 1700). ¹⁻²

In 1880 William Asher was a carpenter.

1895 Lamson owned the homestead in 1895.³




