1907 The Oliver Ward family moved to Hugo, Oregon in 1907 and purchased land from the McCormick family above what is now Hasis Road.³ Nelson was one of their children.

1920 There was a surprise party on Miss Iva Wright Friday evening, last. Quite a number of Three Pines people were in attendance, also Gus Springer, Miss Millicent Kiphart and Alberta Bigeman of Winona; Mrs. Allen and daughter Eva, of Grants Pass, and Frank Ward of Hugo. *Rogue River Courier*. January 30, 1920. <u>Three Pines Weekly</u>.

1920 Mr. and Mrs. Nelson Ward arrived Sunday from Needles, Cal., where they spent the winter. April 9, 1920. Hugo.

1920 In 1920 Nelson Ward secured 40 acres of the old original 1861 Military Warrant to Private Rice Benson for service in the 1850s Rogue Indian Wars. When W. G. Vanderbilt died in 1920 his widow sold the land to Nelson. Nelson operated a range cattle operation on the ranch and did general farming.³

1920 The young people of Three Pines and Frank Ward from Hugo had an enjoyable time Thursday evening. The played games by the light of a large bon fire. *Rogue River Courier*. March 15, 1920. <u>Three Pines Weekly</u>. Mrs. Nelson Ward went to Roseburg Tuesday to spend several months. *Rogue River Courier*. May 7, 1920. <u>Hugo</u>. Nelson Ward went to Roseburg Sunday morning to spend a few days with his wife. *Rogue River Courier*. August 20, 1920. <u>Hugo</u>.

1920 The community was saddened by the news of the death of Mrs. Nelson Ward at Roseburg last Wednesday where she had been in a hospital the past few months. Mrs. Ward will be missed by her host of friends for her cheerful, sunny disposition. She was a member of the first class to graduate from the Hugo high school. *Rogue River Courier*. September 3, 1920. <u>Hugo.</u>


