### 1885 Hugo Homestead On

September 15, 1893 George T.  
McCormick was issued a homestead  
patent for 80 acres in Hugo, Oregon  
(Patent No. 3164).<sup>1-2</sup>

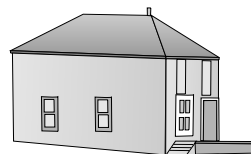

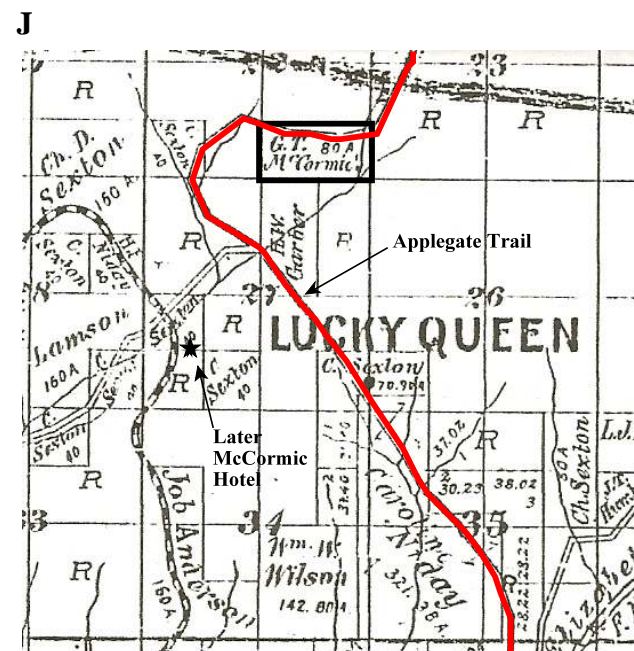
