**Jacob W. Miller** It is assumed for research purposes that Jacob W. Miller, Isabell Miller, and Johanna Miller are related.

**1878** Thirty-three year old Jacob Miller passed February 21, 1878.<sup>1</sup> He is buried in the Pleasant Valley Cemetery (PVC).

**1879** Johanna Bryant was married to Alonzo Bryant November 1 1879 in Josephine County, Oregon. Her maiden name? was Miller (Vol. 2, p. 289; p. 9 is Joanna Bryant).<sup>2</sup>

**1882 Jacob W. Miller's Hugo Cash Entry** In 1882 Jacob Miller was issued a cash entry patent for 80 acres in Hugo, Oregon (Patent No. 4556).<sup>3-4</sup>



### 1885 Joanna Bryant's Hugo

**Homestead** In 1885 Joanna Bryant (Johanna Miller) was issued a homestead patent for 160 acres in Hugo, Oregon (Patent No. 1737).<sup>3-4</sup>

**1930** Isabell Catherine Miller passed January 18, 1930 in Josephine County, Oregon.<sup>6</sup>

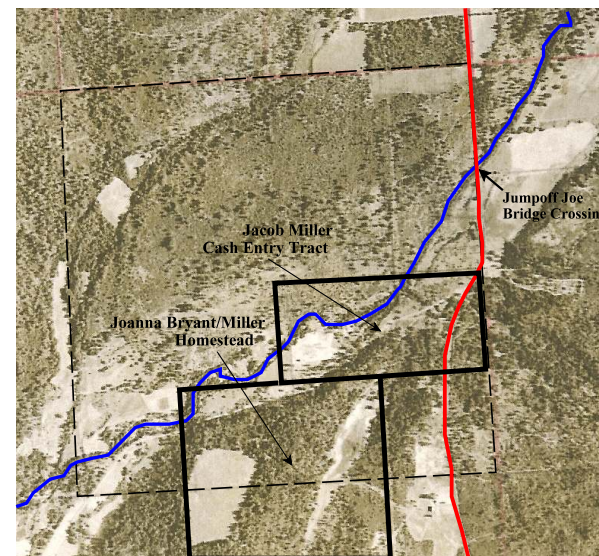
