It has information on master title plats, historical indices, survey plats and notes. It gives the user an opportunity to view information by township and range.

For example, Township 34 South, Range 6 West, Willamette Meridian is T. 34S., R. 6W., WM The township translates into 034-0S. The range translates into 006-0W. Leave the Field Order Note at the default of Boundary, Survey Year. Hit SEARCH.

Township: 034-0S Range: 006-0W The user is now on a web page of the specific township. It provides three types of information.

- Master Title Plats, Use Plats and Historical Indices.
- 2. Survey Plats.
- 3. Field Note Records.

Historical Indices The historical indices page provides table information on the township (patent number, patent date, type of entry: homestead, donation land claim, etc., amount of acres and legal description by sub-divisions of a section).

Master Title Plat The master title/use plat page is a map of the township with the sub-divisions of the sections by the patent numbers provided in the historical indices page.

Survey Plats The survey plats page for our example township has eight cadastral survey plats. Our two GLO maps of interest and the DLC map as well as some other maps are provided here. In our example for Township: 034-0S Range: 006-0W, the first three maps are the ones we are interested in. They are the oldest


Its history mission is to educate, collect, preserve, interpret, and research its local history and to encourage public interest in the history of the Hugo area.
