Mr. and Mrs. Dixon came out [Hugo] from Grants Pass Sunday to see her parents, Mr. and Mrs. Crockett. Bob Crockett and wife of Leland, were over also.³

1901 Mrs. Robert Crockett was the guest of Judge Crockett at Hugo last week. Robert Crockett is pushing his work as fast as possible so as to have his section [Leland] in good shape when winter comes.⁴

1902 Our section daily improves under the supervision of Mr. R. Crockett, section foreman of Hugo. He exchanged section with our friend Mr. Tolson, who now resides at Leland. Bob must seem at home for he was raised at Hugo.⁵




