McKenzie, John, and Charles Trimble's occupation was farmer. John G. Williams was a farm laborer.

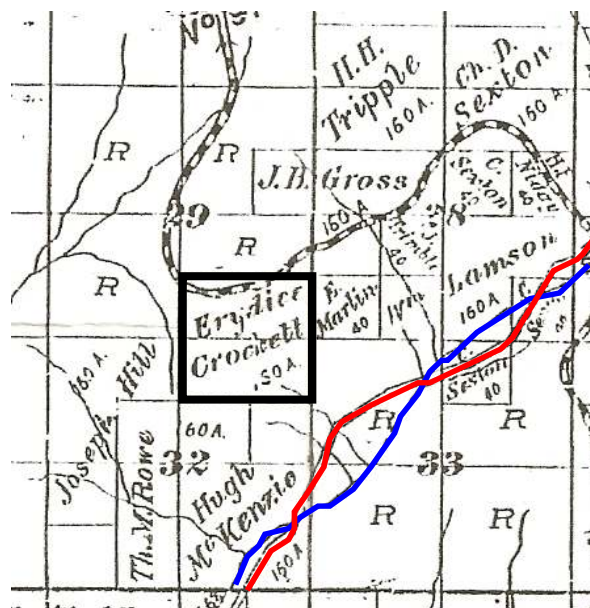
MacKenzie Trimble Family, Hugo Pioneers: 1870 - ca., 1895



1885 MacKenzie Trimble Cash

Entry Trimble purchased 160 acres under Cash Entry No. 5510 in Josephine County, Oregon. It was issued May 9, 1885 to Mackenzie Trimble (April 24, 1820: Sale-Cash Entry (3 Stat. 566)).¹⁻²

1886 Mackenzie Trimble and Martha Ticia McVay married February 14, 1886 at Smith River, Del Norte County, California.

Cash Entry Tract

1895 The Crocketts (Mackenzie's sister, Eurydica (Trimble) Crockett and her husband Garret) are living on Mackenzie's old 160 acre Hugo farm near Tunnel No. 9 (Patent 5510).³

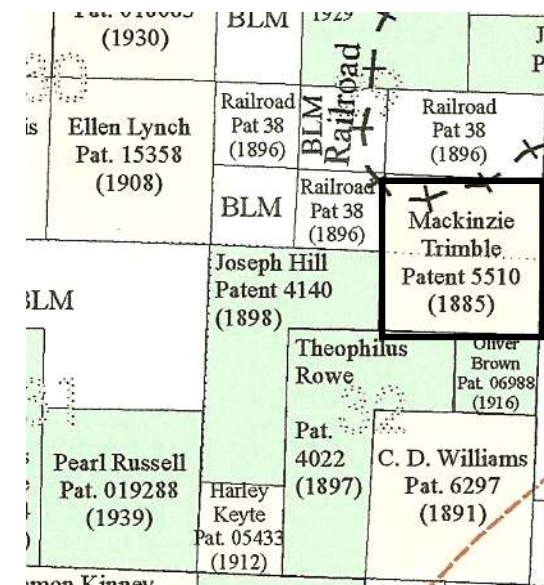
