1885 Hugo Homestead In 1885 Clementina Trimble was issued a homestead patent for 171.66 acres in Hugo, Oregon (Patent No. 1781).

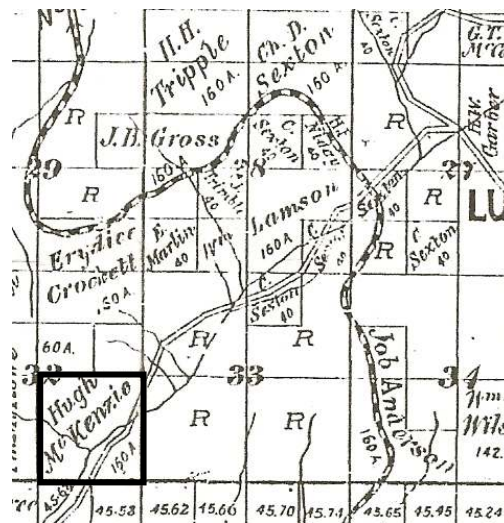


The C. D. Williams Family, Hugo Pioneers: ca., 1891 - 1895

1891 Williams' Hugo Cash Entry Williams purchased 160 acres under Cash Entry No. 6297 in Josephine County, Oregon. It was issued June 22, 1891 to C. D. Williams (April 24, 1820: Sale-Cash Entry (3 Stat. 566)).^{1&2} Charles' acreage was adjacent to the 1885 Trimble homestead.

1891 On August 26, 1891 Charles D. Williams and Mary Ellen Trimble married in Josephine County, Oregon.

1895 By 1895 Hugh McKenzie was in possession of the Williams homestead.³

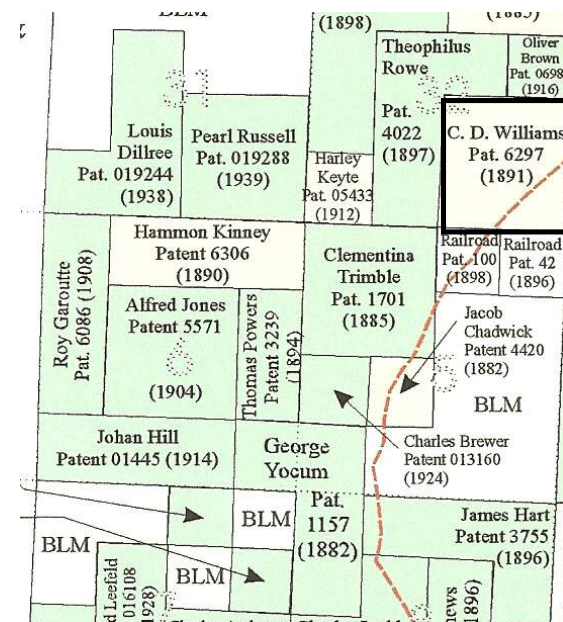
