

1895 W^m W. Wilson was proving up his 142.8 acre homestead in Hugo, Oregon in 1895.¹

1898 Hugo Homestead On November 11, 1898 William W. Wilson was issued a homestead patent for 142.8 acres in Hugo, Oregon (Patent No. 4346).²⁻³



1910 "Three Pines Fruit Tracts" The 1910 *Fruit Tracts* subdivided the land into five acre parcels where it was advertized that one could make a good living raising fruit. It was adjacent and to the east of the Town of Three Pines. The *Fruit Tracts* were originally the William W. Wilson 142.8 acre homestead.

Three Pines Fruit Tracts

1910 Main Roads The two north-south roads in the Three Pines Fruit Tracts were identified as Anderson and Wilson streets. These streets were named after the two homesteaders from which the land for the Town of Three Pines and the Three Pines Fruit Tracts were derived from.


