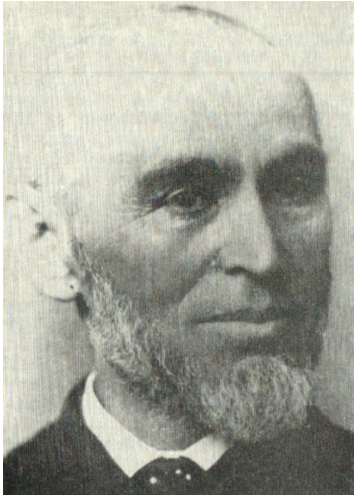

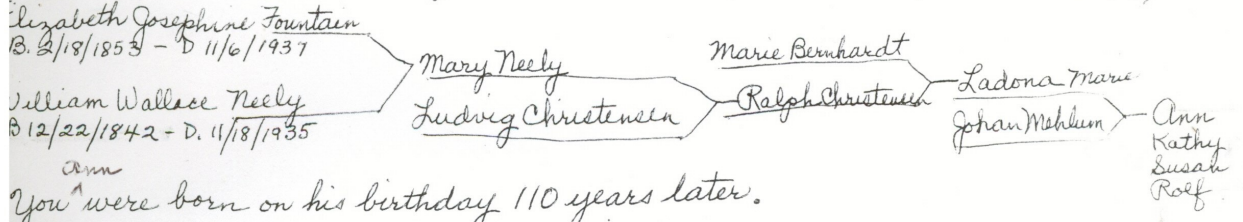

This is a picture of your great great grandfather William Wallace Neely, and his wife Elizabeth Fountain Neely. They were married in 1871 at Walterville Lane Cou Oregon. They were married 64 years. He died in 1935, she 2 years later. They had 9 children. Five died before age 6 (Three died on one day Oct 1, 1882 of typhoid the surviving children were Tom, Mary (your great grandmother Christensen) Louella and Emma. Emma is playing the organ in this picture. The children are Tom's boys Lele Lawrence. The woman holding Lawrence is the schoolteacher (name unknown).



You were born on his birthday 110 years later.  
 William Wallace Neely was the 8<sup>th</sup> of 11 children. He was born in Cedar Co. Missouri  
 Elizabeth Josephine Fountain was the 4<sup>th</sup> of 12 children. Born in Boone Co. Missouri

James Neely was 5 years older than His brother William Wallace Neely  
 Mary married Ludvig Christensen and they were the parents of Clifton, Ralph, Olga and Ina. Ralph was father of Bessie and Ladona.

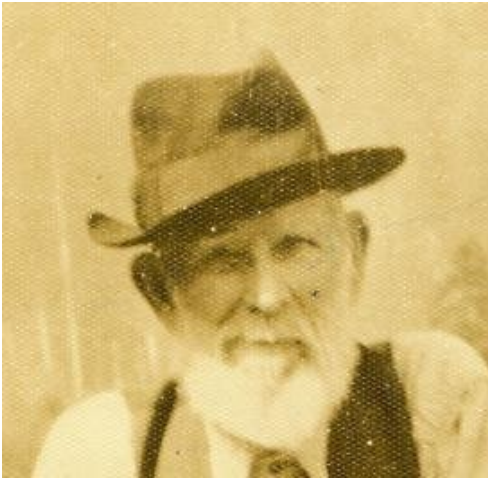
