Hi Mike,

To be listed with the Oregon Commission on Historic Cemeteries at burial site must include the burial of at least one person who died before February 14, 1909. The survey forms I sent you were sufficient to list the cemetery with the commission. Anyone can list a cemetery. If the cemetery or burial site is not operating, and meets the above qualification, then it is required to be listed.

The designation as an archaeological site is a different process and relates to different laws. Please contact Dennis Griffin again to find out more about this designation.
