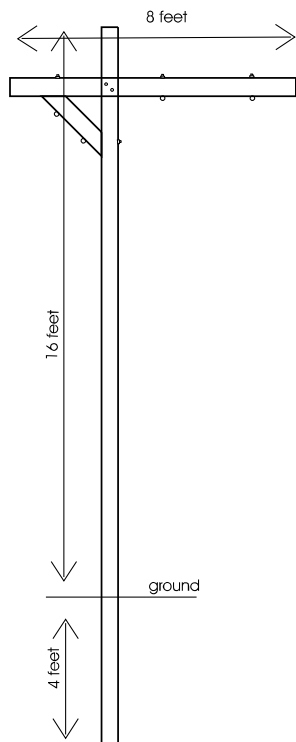


Maintenance of Sign Support Structure

The Hugo Neighborhood Association & Historical Society's Community Sign Maintenance Committee is actually two committees:

1. Maintenance of Sign Support Structure Committee, and
2. Maintenance of Signs Committee.

Maintenance of Sign Support Structure Committee



The Chair of the Maintenance of Sign Support Committee is Tom Walker. His assistant is Mike Walker. The purpose of this committee is the necessary maintenance of the structural integrity of the vertical and horizontal beams that comprise the support system for the four signs. This committee is presently working on a design which will prevent the east horizontal beam holding the signs from sagging. This committee is also responsible for safely taking down and putting up the four signs as needed for maintenance..

Maintenance of Four Signs

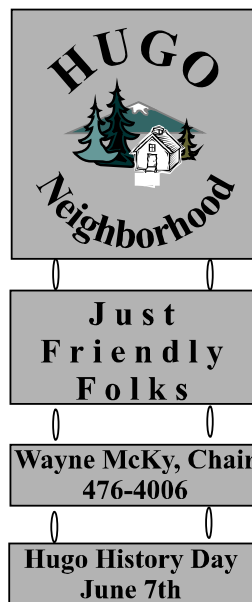
The Hugo Community Sign was installed in phases. The structure was installed July 2002. The hanging signs were installed on sign dedication day which was May 10, 2003.

Maintenance of Signs Committee

The Chair of the Maintenance of Signs Committee is Wayne McKy. The purpose of this committee is the necessary maintenance of the four signs hanging from the sign support structure. This occurred the first time during the spring of 2006. Blake and Jacque Hardwick, Janet McKy, and Mike Walker refurbished the four signs

The major task of the Chair is to periodically inspect the signs and determine when maintenance is needed. The job also includes coordinating volunteers to do the work of sign maintenance.

Janet McKy and Mike Walker volunteered to be responsible for the next maintenance of the sign (e.g., coordinate the specific hands-on effort, actually do the work, find other volunteers to do the work secure needed tools and materials, etc.).

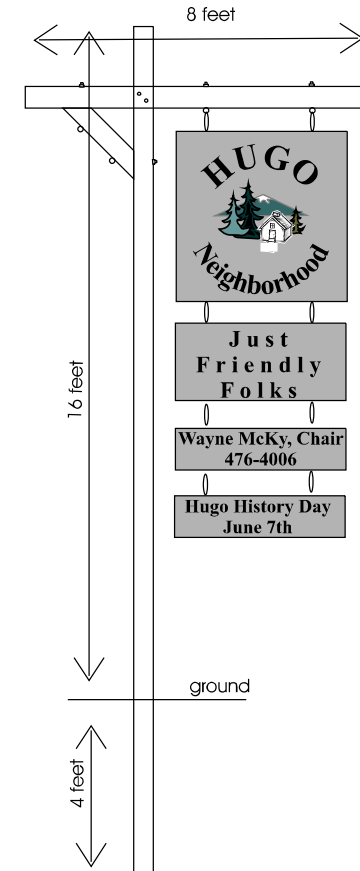
