JO CO JS&PSS The 2012 expiration of federal funding for public safety services resulted in two JO CO proposed levies as a solution. They both failed. The *Exploratory Committee* has a question: "Is JO CO providing a minimally adequate level of PSS?"¹⁻²

NWCW RT Focuses On Crime Prevention It is a fact that the RT is a group of trained armed citizens that strongly supports law enforcement and that the use of fire arms by private citizens is a last resort. Due to extreme liability concerns, the NVCW & RT will not respond to incidents where law enforcement maintains a current policy of response. Training and deterrence are critical.

North Valley Community Watch (NVCW) Response Team (RT)

NWCW RT TRAINING Since the spring of 2012, the RT has engaged in an on-going discussion and scenario based training in Oregon law.

Oregon Law as it pertains to the following concepts.

- Use of Force (ref applicable law ORSs & OARs, Training manuals, etc.)

- Defusing a Potential Violent Encounter (ref law)
- Making a Citizen's Arrest (ref law)
- Self Defense (ref law)
- Use of Force in Defending Another (ref law)
- Limitations on the Use of Deadly Physical Force and in Defense of Property (ref law)

RT Firearms Training RT members train in the safe deployment of firearms, handling of firearms in a confrontation, accurate shooting of firearms.
