The 2012 expiration of federal funding for services resulted in two JO CO proposed levies as a solution. They both failed.

- May 2012 JO CO-wide Measure 17 43, Criminal Justice System Operations Four Year Local Option Tax (i.e., \$1.99 per \$1,000 of assessed value), failed 57 - 43 percent.
- May 2013 JO CO-wide Measure 17 49, Criminal Justice and Public Safety Three Year Local Option Tax (i.e., \$1.48 per \$1,000 of assessed value), failed 51 - 49 percent.
