& 38C Foehlin Gravelly Loam Soil**

The North Oxbow trail location is an alternative working hypothesis location based upon a logging road on a ridge (Penny Ridge), road traces, saddles, and White's pasture road as well as a route that in some places would have been sidling for an emigrant wagon. Both ends of the North Oxbow are found on the ground: 1. West end is Penny Ridge, and 2. East end is White's pasture road.
