September 2, 2010 The 1954 USGS topo clearly identifies Rat Creek flowing north into Grave Creek.

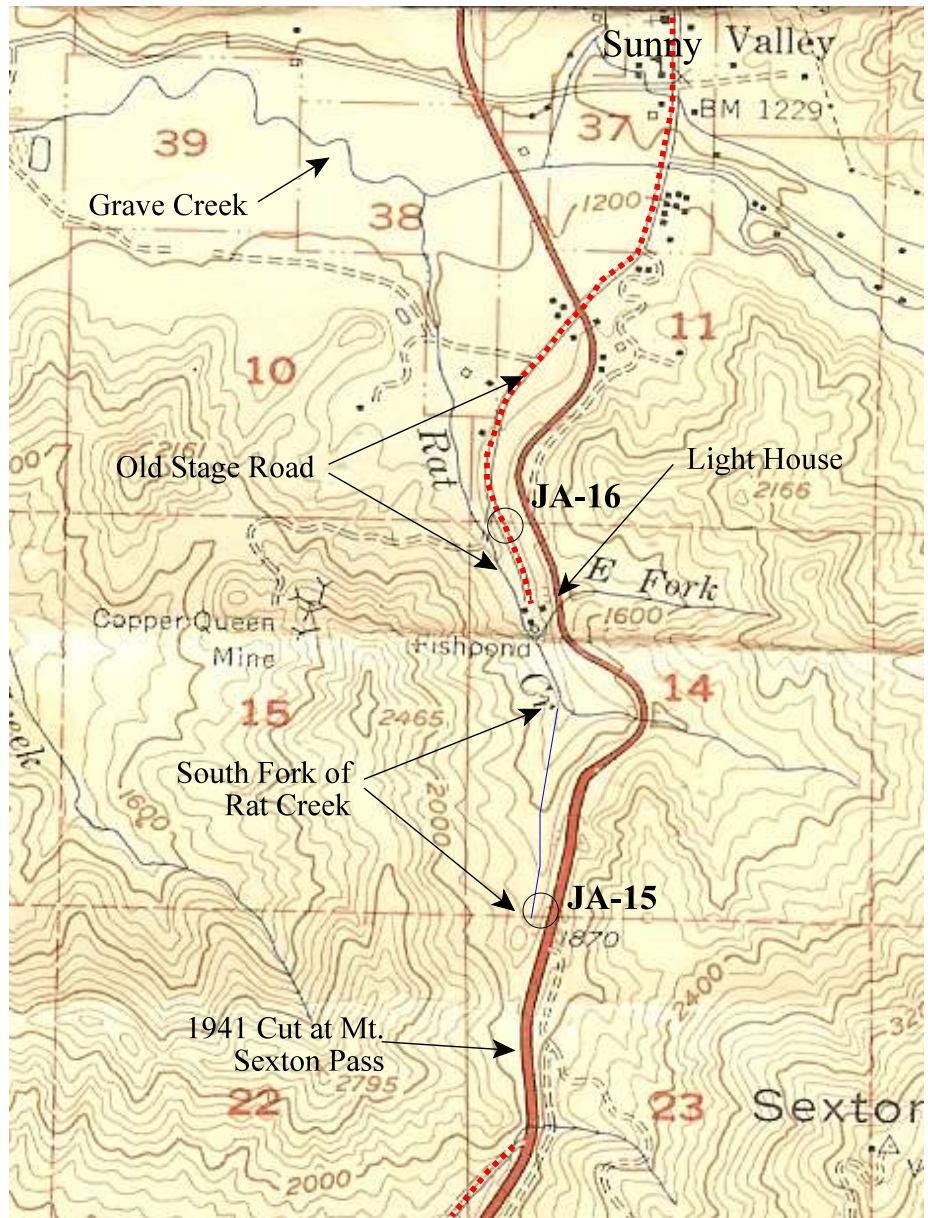
The main stem of Rat Creek flows to the east in the middle of Section 14. An East Fork of Rat Creek is identified, as well as the north-south drainage of South Fork Rat Creek.

The 1920 - 1921 paved Pacific Highway clearly is identified in red, including the 1941 cut at Mt. Sexton Pass.

The old Light house along the Applegate Trail and the later Liedecker fishpond is identified at the confluence of Rat Creek and East Fork of Rat Creek. This confluence is also the southern end of today's Old Stage Road east of Rat Creek.

JA-15 plots to the east of Rat Creek.

JA-16 plots almost on top of Old Stage Road east of Rat Creek.
