September 2, 2010 The 1932 Metsker Map clearly shows a unimproved road west of Rat Creek from Mt. Sexton Pass down past JA-16 and no roads on the east side except the Pacific Highway uphill to the east.

The dark black line is the paved 1920 - 1921 Pacific Highway in 1932.

1855 JA-16 plots in Rat Creek which is much further east than 1932 road which is west of creek.

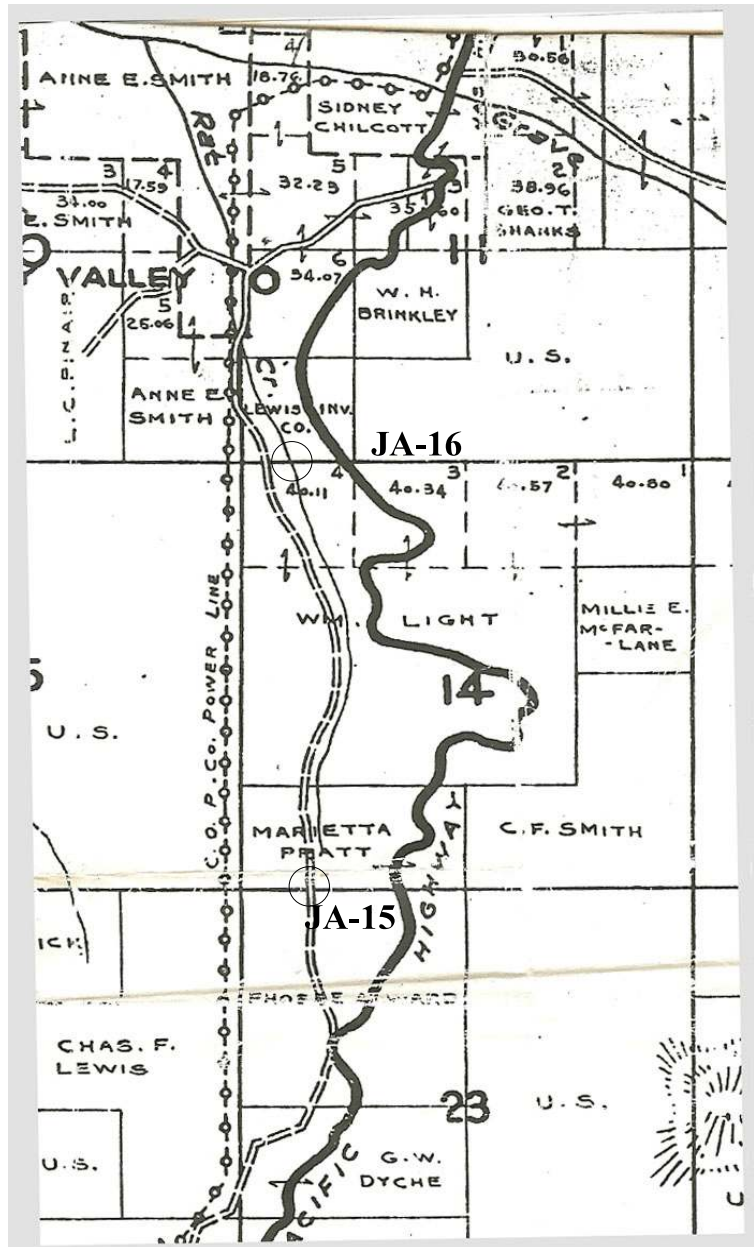

1893 GLO JA-15 plots on the 1932 road; road is west of Rat Creek if creek is extended south.

13.10 Grants Pass and Canyonville Roads course N. and S. (13.1 chains = 864.6'; Rat Creek was 92.4' from road]
