Thank you for this opportunity to comment on the Rogue National Wild and Scenic River: Hellgate Recreation Area — Proposed Recreation Management Plan and Final Environmental Impact Statement (Hellgate RAMP/FEIS).

Most of our February 15, 2001 comments about inadequate procedural requirements on the DEIS are applicable to the FEIS, especially for Chapter 4, the environmental consequences chapter. The environmental consequences chapter does not comply with the procedural requirements of the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) and our concerns are pretty much the same as identified in our February 15, 2001 letter (i.e., I. Introduction, II. Procedural Requirements, and appendices A, B, C, D).
