

**Three Pines**

The town of Three Pines, in Josephine County, is booming, according to the statement of G. E. Howard, a leading lumber manufacturer of that place. The Three Pines Lumber Company, operating a large sawmill at that place, is making substantial improvements in its plant. A new planing mill is almost ready for operation and a new sawmill is being erected as rapidly as possible.

About 400,000,000 feet of timber are to be flumed down and cut at this mill. The town now has 100 inhabitants, two stores, and a hotel. A great many houses will be built there this winter as nearly everyone at this time is living in a tent.

The town now has three trains a day stopping there and a new depot has been built.
